

2001-02 IHSAA Football State Tournament Series

State Finals Summary

Ben Davis, Jasper, Indianapolis Bishop Chatard, Fort Wayne Bishop Luers and Southern Wells each captured their respective state championships in the 29th Annual IHSAA Football State Finals on November 23-24, 2001 at the RCA Dome in Indianapolis. A total of 309 schools and 16,720 players began competition at the sectional level.

Attendance for Friday's two games was 14,753, while Saturday's three-game session drew 26,807 for a two-day total of 41,560 spectators.

Class 5A

Ben Davis Wins Second Title in Three Years

Senior quarterback/defensive back James Banks scored two touchdowns as top-ranked Ben Davis re-claimed the Class 5A state championship with a 35-16 victory over third-ranked Valparaiso.

Banks scored on runs of 1 and 41 yards and picked off two Valparaiso passes. His second touchdown run put the Giants up 21-7 with 8:32 remaining in the third quarter and his fourth quarter interception return of 58 yards, a Class 5A record, set up Garrett Phillips' 18 yard score two plays later. Banks finished the game with 118 yards on 16 carries and was 5-for-9 passing for 85 yards and one touchdown. He was intercepted twice.

With its second championship in three years, Ben Davis won its record sixth football state championship tying Sheridan for the most in tournament history. The Giants also won in 1987, 1988, 1990, 1991 and 1999. All have come in Class 5A and under the guidance of Coach Dick Dullaghan. Dullaghan, coaching in his 10th championship game, won his record seventh state title also having guided Carmel to the 1978 Class 3A championship. Only the late Don Howell, with 11 appearances at Hobart, has coached in more IHSAA championship football games.

Valparaiso tied the score at 7-7 midway through the second quarter on quarterback Jason Renn's one yard run, but Ben Davis took the momentum into the lockerroom when Banks hooked up with Zachary Rainey on a 34 yard pass with :56 left in the second quarter.

Carl Gioia's 21-yard field goal with 11:52 to go in the fourth quarter and Mike Dorulla's 28-yard fumble recovery for a touchdown with 4:14 left accounted for Valpo's other scores.

Dontae Hart finished off the Ben Davis scoring with a 1 yard run with 1:58 to go for the final margin.

Matt Handlon of Valparaiso High School was selected by the IHSAA Executive Committee as the 2001 recipient of the Phil N. Eskew Award for Mental Attitude in Class 5A Football. Farm Bureau Insurance, corporate partner of the IHSAA, presented a \$1,000 scholarship to Valparaiso High School in the name of Handlon.

Class 4A

Lewis' Record Four TDs Gives Jasper, Coach Brewer First Football Championship

Two fourth quarter touchdown runs by Jasper running back Brian Lewis helped the third-ranked Wildcats claim their first state championship in football – a 35-20 decision over sixth-ranked Delta.

Lewis' Class 4A record-tying fourth touchdown run, a four-yarder with 2:21 left in the game, helped seal the victory for the team and its 43rd-year coach Jerry Brewer. Lewis' score and the point after put Jasper out of danger after Delta pulled within eight points.

Brewer, Indiana's all-time winningest coach with 357 victories, celebrated his first state championship after guiding the Wildcats to the state finals for the fifth time in his career.

It was Jasper's seventh state title in school history and its sixth in the last seven years. Jasper claimed baseball titles in 1996, 1997, 1998 and 2000 and won the boys tennis state championship in 1999.

Lewis' third touchdown run came with 5:34 remaining in the game and capped a 16-play, 76-yard drive that took 9:30 off the clock. Lewis carried the ball 11 of the 16 plays on the drive. His score put Jasper up 28-13, but Delta came back with a quick strike as Joey Lynch tossed a 9 yard pass to Chris Jackson that made it 28-20. The drive encompassed seven plays and 80 yards but only took :58 seconds.

Lewis finished with 35 carries for 211 yards setting Class 4A records for points scored (24), touchdowns scored, rushing yards and rushing touchdowns. Quarterback Ben Schmidt ran 10 times for 73 yards and Chris Schmidt caught four passes for 65 yards.

Lynch completed 12 of 21 passes for 201 yards and two touchdowns for Delta (13-2). The Eagles, making their first appearance in the state finals, were coached by Grant Zgunda.

Alex Hensley of Jasper High School was selected by the IHSAA Executive Committee as the 2001 recipient of the Phil N. Eskew Award for Mental Attitude in Class 4A Football. Farm Bureau Insurance, corporate partner of the IHSAA, presented a \$1,000 scholarship to Jasper High School in the name of Hensley.

Class 3A

Second Quarter Field Goal Good Enough For Bishop Chatard

Defense was the name of the game in the Class 3A state championship game as Indianapolis Bishop Chatard claimed a 3-0 victory from Andean in the lowest scoring championship game in state finals history.

The previous lowest output was six points scored in the 1992-93 Class A title game when Sheridan defeated Indianapolis Ritter, 6-0.

For Bishop Chatard, who was coached by Tom Dilley, it was the school's fifth state championship in football with the others coming in 1983 (2A), 1984 (2A), 1997 (3A) and 1998 (3A). Its five titles ranks tied for second most in state history.

Both teams' defense held their opponents under 150 yards of total offense as Andean managed just 103 yards, 89 of it through the air, while Bishop Chatard picked up only 137. Seven of Andean's 10 drives during the game resulted in a punt while Bishop Chatard was forced to punt on eight of its 11 possessions.

The lone score of the game came with 2:18 left before halftime when Bishop Chatard got on the board thanks to Andy Nuss' 28 yard field goal. The drive, which went for 13 plays over 60 yards ate up 5:46 of the second quarter clock. It was the most sustained drive of the game by either team.

It was the fifth shutout of the year authored by the Trojans and the second of the post-season. It was the first time the 59ers have been held scoreless since a season-opening loss to Hobart in 2000. Coached by Jeff Karras, Andean (13-2) finished as the runner-up in Class 3A for the second time in as many appearances. Andean lost a last-minute thriller to Bishop Chatard, 27-24, in the 1997 championship game.

For Bishop Chatard (11-4), its four losses were the most for a state championship team since Sheridan finished 10-4 in winning the 1992 Class A title.

Class 2A

Bishop Luers Runs Away Late To Avenge Last Year's Defeat

Fort Wayne Bishop Luers broke open a close game in the final minutes for a 57-29 victory over defending state champion Evansville Mater Dei in the Class 2A title contest.

For second-ranked Bishop Luers, it was their fifth football title overall and the second in three years. The Knights also avenged last year's 56-10 state championship game defeat to Evansville Mater Dei. Each of Bishop Luers' previous state titles – 1985, 1989, 1992 and 1999 – also came in Class 2A. Matt Lindsay has been the coach for the last four championships guiding this year's team to a 14-0 record, its first undefeated championship campaign.

With Bishop Luers leading 36-29 and facing a 4th and 14 from the Mater Dei 27 yard line, backup quarterback Eric Smith, who came in to replace an injured Kyle Lindsay, rolled to his right and hit a wide open Jhormy Martinez who scored and seemingly put the game out of reach with 2:34 remaining.

On Mater Dei's next play from scrimmage, Luers' Tony Kleber intercepted his second Jake Schiff pass of the game and returned it to the Wildcat 15 yard line. Martinez ran it in on the ensuing play for his third rushing touchdown of the day to make it 50-29. He finished with a game high 122 yards on 20 carries. Brian Kurtz then intercepted Schiff's next pass from scrimmage and returned it for a score with 1:56 remaining. The final three touchdowns came just :38 seconds apart.

Schiff, the state's single season and career passing leader with 4,468 and 12,195 yards respectively, finished the game 39-for-54 with 439 yards and three touchdowns. He was intercepted three times. Schiff managed to set overall state finals records for completions, attempts and yardage in a game.

Top-ranked Mater Dei had taken its only lead of the game at 22-21 on a 10 yard inside route on the left side from Schiff to Blake Kollker, but Luers answered on its next possession. Anthony Spencer's two yard plunge with 4:53 remaining in the third quarter put the Knights back on top and Lindsay hit Eric Smith in the right corner for the two point conversion to make it 29-22. Lindsay finished the game 6-for-11 for 154 yards and two touchdowns.

Bishop Luers had jumped out to a 14-0 lead in the opening minutes with Steve Shank hauling in a 48 yard pass from Lindsay for a 7-0 lead. On their next possession, Martinez, Luers' leading ground gainer this season, ran it in from 24 yards out with 5:38 remaining in the first quarter.

Mater Dei, coached by Mike Goebel, got on the board with a 60 yard touchdown pass from Schiff to Patrick Mallory to make it 14-6.

Following a 31 yard field goal by Mater Dei's Logan Miller in the second quarter that made it 14-9, Mater Dei turned it over on its next possession when Schiff was picked off by Kleber who returned it for a 12 yard score.

In the closing minute of the first half, Mater Dei recovered a fumble in Luers territory that gave the Wildcats another chance at the endzone. After a 22-yard reception and a nifty move after the catch by Craig Moore, who was tackled at the Luers' two yard line, Patrick Mallory scored three plays later on an end around play to the left side from one yard out with :07 left. The two-point conversion failed making the score 21-15 at the half. Mallory, who set the overall state finals mark with 192 yards receiving also broke the record for receiving yards in a single season with 1,795. He finished third on the state's career receiving chart with 2,993 yards.

Mater Dei receiver Blake Kollker also recorded 14 receptions the most ever in a state championship game at any level.

Farm Bureau Insurance, corporate partner of the IHSAA, presented a \$1,000 scholarship to Bishop Luers High School in the name of Lindsay.

Class A

Big Second Half Seals Southern Wells' Upset Victory

Four second half scores allowed Southern Wells to upset top-ranked and previously unbeaten Perry Central, 30-7, in the Class A state championship game.

It was the first state title in any sport for Southern Wells (14-1) as well as the first for any Wells County school. The Raiders were coached by Mark Lefebvre.

Southern Wells' staked its claim with three long second half scoring drives and a long interception return late in the game. The Raiders three scoring drives ate up 18:12 of the clock keeping Perry Central's high-scoring offense off the field.

With the score tied 7-7 at halftime, Robert Carroll's 11 yard run with 5:51 left in the third quarter put the Raiders up 14-7. His score capped an 11 play, 56 yard drive that used up 6:08. The Raiders added Derek Leas' 32 yard field goal with 9:45 left in the game. That 12 play drive only gained 39 yards, but took 6:32 off the clock as well. Tucker Benedict's 2 yard run with 2:01 remaining ate up 5:32. Benedict finished with a game high 131 yards on 28 carries.

The Raiders picked off Perry Central quarterback Shon Hubert with 1:24 left as Caleb Sleppy returned the interception from his own 28 to the Perry Central 39 before fumbling. Jonathon Tucker picked up the loose ball in stride carrying it the remaining 39 yards for the game's final score.

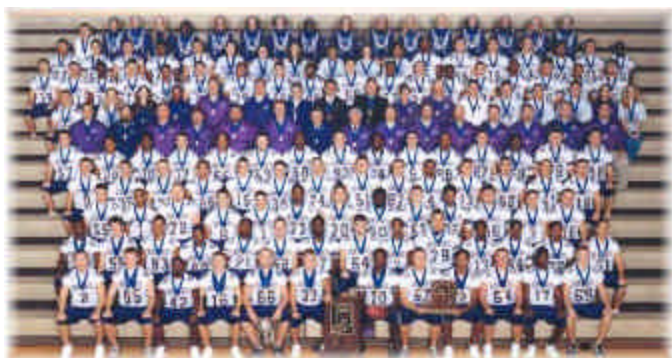
Perry Central's defense came into the championship game only allowing 41 points all year, including just one touchdown in tournament play.

Southern Wells, making its first appearance in the state finals in a team sport, went up 7-0 on its first possession with Tucker Benedict's first touchdown of the day, a one yard run with 6:37 remaining in the opening quarter.

Perry Central (14-1), coached by Mike Spencer, knotted the game at 7-7 just before halftime on Shon Hubert's 54 yard pass to D.J. Krieg down the right sideline with 0:47 remaining.

This was the second time in three years the Commodores finished as the runner-up after falling to Lafayette Central Catholic, 59-7, in 1999.

Peter Wagner of Southern Wells High School was selected by the IHSAA Executive Committee as the 2001 recipient of the Phil N. Eskew Award for Mental Attitude in Class A Football. Farm Bureau Insurance, corporate partner of the IHSAA, presented a \$1,000 scholarship to Southern Wells High School in the name of Wagner.



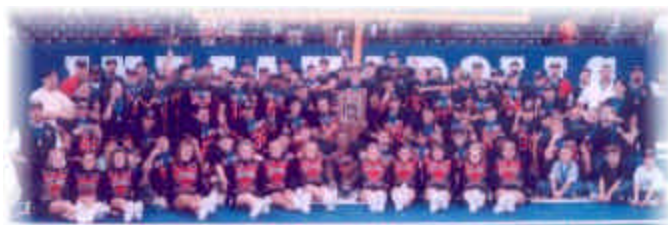

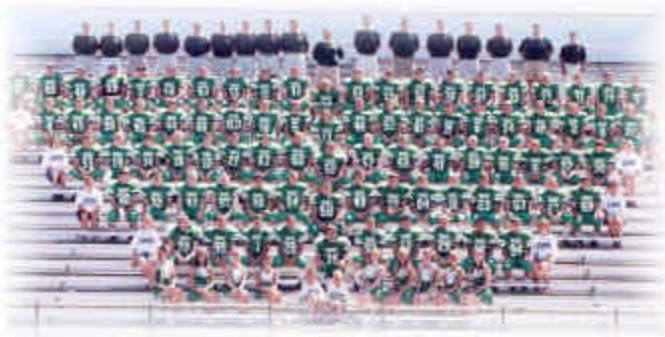

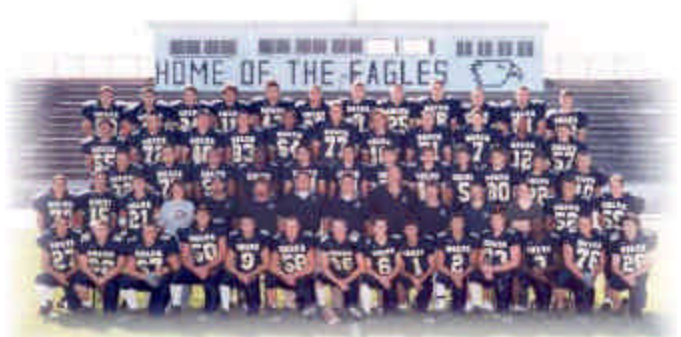
