State Finals Summary

Carmel Three-Peats With 4-0 Victory Over Bloomington South

Top-ranked and unbeaten Carmel scored three goals in the first half and continued its dominance on the field defeating Bloomington South, 4-0, to win the IHSAA state championship on November 2, 2002 at Kuntz Memorial Stadium in Indianapolis.

It was the third consecutive state title for the Greyhounds and their sixth in the nine-year history of the tournament. Despite their previous title teams, this edition of the Greyhounds, at 25-0, became the first girls team to finish the season unbeaten and untied. Frank Dixon has been the coach for all six championship teams.

The Greyhounds last defeat came in the final match of the 2000-01 regular season, a 2-1 loss to Center Grove. Since then they have reeled off an amazing 52-0-1 record allowing only 12 goals during that stretch with no opponent scoring more than one in a match.

Junior Anne Sommer scored Carmel's first two goals of the night with the first a header from inside the box in the fifth minute of the match. Her second goal was a tap in at the 16:00 mark. Senior Mary Beth Robinson gave her team a 3-0 lead at 29:16 with another header that found its way past the Bloomington South goalie. In the second half sophomore Angie Muir, who assisted on Sommer's second goal, stuck another into the back of the net unassisted at 62:00 to account for the final score.

Unranked Bloomington South, which finished 18-5-2, defeated Chesterton, 1-0, in a penalty kick shootout (5-4) to earn its first berth in the championship match. This also was Bloomington South's first appearance in the state finals. The Panthers were coached by Matt Wilhoit.

Carmel, meanwhile, eliminated previously unbeaten Fort Wayne Snider, 4-1, in the other semifinal match. It would turn out to be the only goal allowed by Carmel in its eight post-season matches.

Meghan Marie Fowler-Finn of Fort Wayne Snider was selected by the IHSAA Executive Committee as recipient of the 2002 Mental Attitude Award in Girls Soccer. Farm Bureau Insurance, IHSAA corporate partner, presented a \$1,000 scholarship to Snider High School in the name of Fowler-Finn.
