

Seven of eight state finalist teams have returned from a year ago and seven top 10 teams including defending state champion and second-ranked Indianapolis Cathedral.

Four quarterfinal matches will be played Friday at 3 pm ET at Carmel and Center Grove high schools with the winning teams advancing to the semifinal matches on Saturday at 10 am ET at North Central High School followed by the state championship match at 2 pm ET.

- Second-ranked Indianapolis Cathedral (17-1) is the defending state champion winning its first crown since 1986 a year ago. The Irish are making their third consecutive appearance in the state finals and fourth in six years. Cathedral, coached by Mark Noe, have faced four ranked opponents during their tournament run, the most of any team in the field and also defeated finalists South Bend St. Joseph and Center Grove during the regular season. Their only loss was a 3-2 setback at Carmel. Sophomore Claire Koscielski is 24-0 at No. 3 singles while sister Maeve Koscielski, the defending state singles champion is 23-1 at No. 1 this season.
- Top-ranked and unbeaten Carmel (16-0) makes its ninth consecutive state finals appearance, extending its state record streak. Prior to last season, the Greyhounds won three consecutive state crowns and there's plenty of experience and tradition on their side. Junior Lauren Lemonds is 22-0 at No. 1 singles this season.
- Third-ranked Center Grove (20-2) returns to the state finals for a second year in a row. The Trojans went 2-2 against other state finalists during the regular season beating Terre Haute South and Jasper but falling to Carmel and Indianapolis Cathedral. CG won this year's Metropolitan Interscholastic Conference Tournament and boast two 14-0 doubles teams in Cassidy Hardin and Isabella Schoolcraft along with Carleigh Hardin and Ellie Strube.
- No. 4 Providence (19-0) brings a perfect mark into the state finals for the third time overall but first time in 40 years. The Pioneers, who booted #11 Columbus

North 3-2 at the semi-state, turned away fellow finalist Jasper 4-1 in the season opener for both squads April 6. The No. 2 doubles team of Natalie Jacobi and Heidi Popson maintain a perfect ledger at 25-0 while top singles playes Halli Trinkle and Natalie Boesing are 20-1 and 24-1, respectively.

- South Bend St. Joseph (23-1), ranked seventh, is making its second straight visit to this level of the tournament and hope to do one better than last year's state runner-up finish. The Indians only blemish is a 3-2 defeat to Indianapolis Cathedral on May 6, a rematch of last year's championship final. The Northern Indiana Conference champs have reeled off 14 in a row including 5-0 victories in each stop along the tournament. Talle Corrigan and Kayla Graham at No. 1 and Nicole Pascual and Kathryn Borders at No. 2 make up St. Joe's undefeated doubles pairs each at 15-0.
- Eighth-ranked Terre Haute South (23-2) split a pair of meetings with other finalist teams during the regular season falling 3-2 to Center Grove but topping Jasper 4-1 on May 10. The Braves have two unbeatens in their lineup in No. 3 singles player Lily Yeagley at 20-0 and the No. 1 doubles squad of Pamela Dorman and Breanna Rogers at 21-0. The team knocked off No. 15 Avon at last weekend's semi-state to advance to the state finals for the third straight year.
- No. 9 Jasper will compete in the weekend festivities for a third straight year after turning away No. 20 Evansville Memorial 4-1 last weekend. The always-tough Wildcats (17-4) faced three other finalist opponents during the regular season which account for all but one of their losses and that experience helped the program make its 14th appearance in the state finals, fourth-most in state history.
- No. 13 Carroll (Fort Wayne) took down No. 16 Delta by a 3-2 count at the semi-state allowing the Chargers a second straight trip to state and third in five years. Carroll has no seniors and but two juniors in their lineup so the future is bright for the Fort Wayne-area contingent. Sophomore Bailey Newman is 27-1 at No. 3 singles and both doubles teams have only fallen twice this season.
- A total of 312 schools and 3,239 students entered this year's state tournament, just off the record highs of 313 schools set in 2007 and 2008.
